- **Theme:** Together As One
- **Entry Deadline:** Sunday, November 9, 2025, by 5 p.m.
- Where to submit: Crown Point Community Library
- **Eligibility:** Ages 11-13 (as of Nov. 15, 2025)
- Judging Criteria: Originality, Artistic Merit, and Expression of Theme

RULES & GUIDELINES

- Only one entry per student.
- Artwork must be original and created without the use of Al-generated art.
- Size must be between 13"x 20" and 20"x 24".
- No mats, frames, lettering, numbers, or glued materials.
- 3D entries not accepted.
- Artist's signature or initials must appear on the back only.
- Chalk, pastel, or charcoal art must be sealed with fixative spray.
- ARTWORK MUST BE FLEXIBLE FOR ROLLING
 DO NOT FOLD.

AWARDS & RECOGNITION*

- Local Prizes: Top three posters will receive awards from the Crown Point Lions Club.
- First Place Winner: Advances to the district contest for a chance to compete internationally!
- Local Winners Announced: Friday, November 14, 2025
- Awards Presentation: Tuesday, November 18, 2025 (details to follow)

*At the local level, the contest winner will be recognized by the Crown Point Lions Club. Artists of posters advancing to the final international judging are recognized as follows:

- International Grand Prize Winner receives a trip to an award ceremony
 where he/she will receive US\$5,000 (or local equivalent) and an award.
 Two family members (one being the winner's parent or legal guardian)
 and the sponsoring Lions club president or a club member (as
 designated by club president) are invited to accompany the winner to
 the award ceremony.
- 23 Merit Award Winners each receive US\$500 (or local equivalent) and a certificate of achievement.


