LIBRARY UPDATES

EFFECTIVE JULY 5

Meeting Rooms

- Return to pre-pandemic set-up configurations
- No social distancing enforced
- No capacity limits
- Food is allowed

Library Materials Quarantine

- No quarantine of materials starting July 5th
- Material donations to the Library can be brought in anytime during library hours to the Crown Point location. Please pick up a list of items the library accepts at any public library desk

Social Distancing

- No social distancing enforced
- · Elevator directive on limits removed
- · All computers stations will be available for use
- · Seating areas throughout the library are returned

Masks

- No Mask Required:
 - Vaccinated adults and vaccinated children aged 12+
 - Children under 2
- Mask Required:
 - All staff will continue to mask up inside the library throughout July
 - Unvaccinated adults and unvaccinated children aged 2-11
 - One-on-one assistance with staff when social distancing is not possible

LOOKING AHEAD - EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 2021 :

- Library hours will resume:
 - Crown Point: 9 a.m.-8 p.m. Monday Thursday 1-5 p.m. Sunday
 - Winfield: 10 a.m.- 5 p.m. Monday & Wednesday 10 a.m.-7 p.m. Tuesday & Thursday
- Expanded in-person and outdoor programming

Programming

- In-person adult programming to resume as appropriate
- Limited in-person programming for children and teens, primarily outside, may resume as appropriate

Disinfection/cleaning

- Maintenance will disinfect/clean public spaces once
 a day
- Clorox wipes are always made available to patrons

Other

- Drinking fountains return to normal usage
- Game Room reopens
