


NEW eMATERIALS RESOURCE

The Crown Point Community Libary joined almost 200 other libraries throughout Indiana in partnership with the Indiana State Library and OverDrive to create a new collaborative sharing resource to benefit all eMaterial users in the state. This new resource is called the *Indiana Digital Library*. Our patrons will now have access to a wider selection of digital materials, including the addition of eAudio and eMagazines, with less wait time on holds! The recommended app to use to enjoy our digital collection will be Libby (OverDrive will phase out their app by the end of the year.) More information will be available on our website.

Coming soon... OUTDOOR LIBRARY LOCKERS



The library was an award recipient of a grant through the Indiana State Library by the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA). The \$25,936.51 grant will partially fund outdoor remote library lockers. The remote locker system will extend library accessibility by offering self-serve options like pick-up and returns 24/7. Lockers will be available at both locations. Stay tuned for more details about this project and the expected installation date.




CELEBRATING 10 YEARS ON MAIN STREET



ADDITIONAL PUBLIC PARKING

The library has partnered with the City of Crown Point to enhance the parking available around the library. As part of the City's East Street parking improvement plans, the library combined its small north parking lot behind the library with the new larger municipal parking lot the City has created. This created a greater opportunity for library visitors to find parking around the library. In addition, the library will have 18 dedicated parking spots in the existing south municipal lot in front of the library. The addition of on-street parking in front of the police station will also be helpful for library visitors. The library is thrilled with the improvements in parking in order to better serve our community.

Library Director Julie Wendorf, along with Mayor Pete Land, city and library staff, Julie Olthoff State Representative, and members of the Crossroad Chamber of Commerce celebrated the 10-year anniversary of the Crown Point Library opening its building on Main Street!



THE CHARLIE CART PROJECT

The library purchased a Charlie Cart with the assistance of a matching grant from the Crown Point Community Foundation and a gift from the Friends of the Crown Point Library. The purpose of adding the Charlie Cart, a kitchen on wheels, as a tool at the library is to provide the tools and equipment to develop and expand programming that supports the growing need for community health literacy. This unique cart is outfitted with equipment that enables the library to expand free culinary and health literacy programs for all ages in partnership with Governor Holcomb's goal of creating a healthier Indiana.
