ADULTS

- Register online or at the library
- Submit a reading log online or at the library for every two books read.
- Participants will be entered into the prize drawing for every reading log submitted.

- Students will put a bead in their school's jar for every hour of reading.
- The school with the most beads by July 31 wins the trophy!
- All public and private schools in the Crown Point Community School District and homeschool students in grades K-8 are eligible to compete.

Grades 6-12

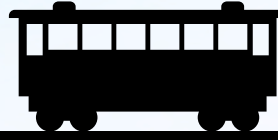

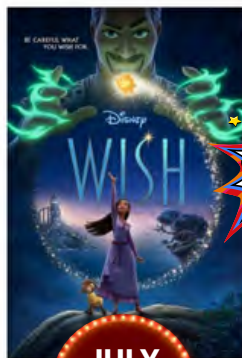

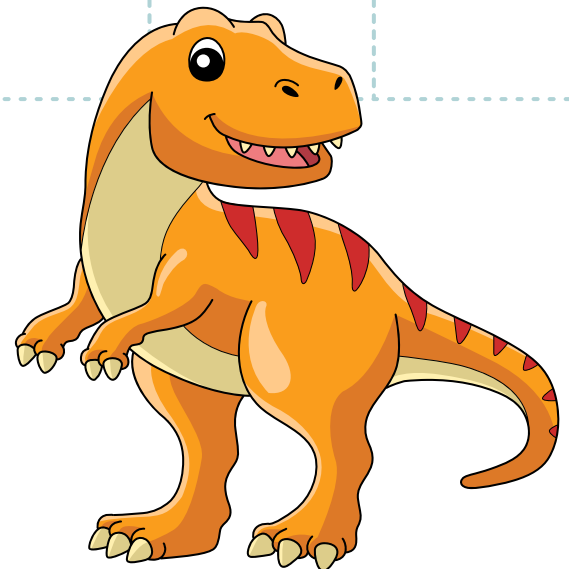
